Sunday Services

The Sunday morning service will resume on March 7th 2021.

The following guidelines will continue to be followed.

Love for one another:

Be aware that different people face different risks and fears from the current situation. As such maintaining social distancing is not about taking care of ourselves, but caring for others. Try and adopt the attitude of "I'm protecting others", rather than "I'm protecting myself".

Services will be shorter as for the time being there will be no singing.

Please follow government guidance in regards to face masks. Please note preaching will be done without a face mask as we have people who lip read.

Communion will be pre prepared in a safe environment. Again it is for the individual to decide if they participate at this time.

Please keep your distance from each other during the service. If you have come as a family or are part of a "bubble" please feel free to move your chairs closer together.

Please avoid touching anything in the centre as much as possible. All toys, nursery equipment etc are strictly off limits. This is a Nursery and we need to maintain a duty of care (love) towards the staff and children as well as ourselves.

The toilets are available, but again where possible please try to avoid using them. Please only use the toilets in the main entrance area.

Doors and windows will be open throughout the service to keep air flowing, be aware that this could get a bit drafty on colder days if this situation continues for a prolonged period.

After the service please continue conversations outside the building in the fresh air where possible.

To maintain distancing there are limits to the number we can have in a room at any time. If too many attend we will hold additional services later in the day or will use an overflow room, this is not just to uphold government guidelines, but is also part of our return agreement with the Early Years Centre.
